



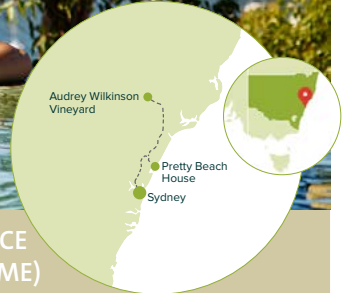

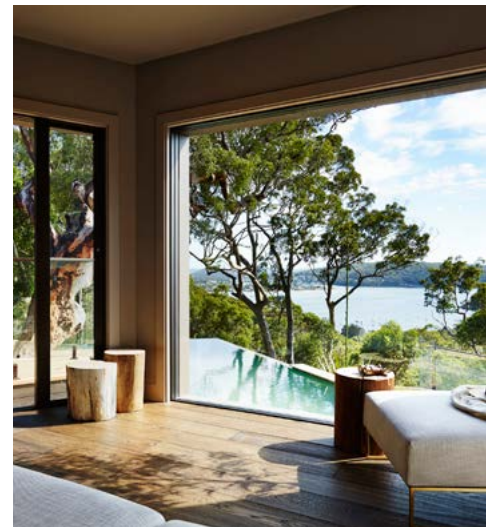
PRETTY BEACH HOUSE, BOUDDI PENINSULA

AUDREY WILKINSON, HUNTER VALLEY

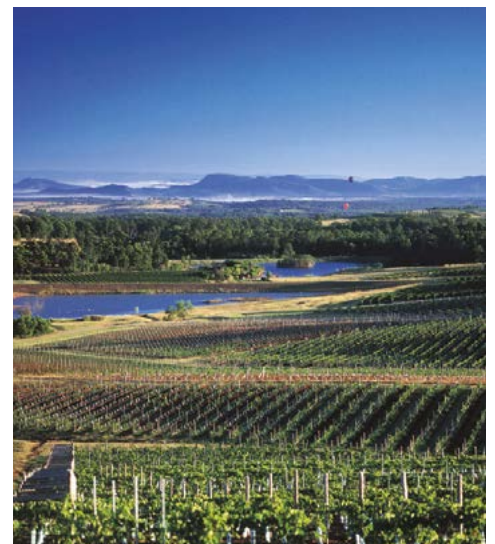
